### **BY-LAW 205-2026**

#### **To assume municipal services located in and on the streets on 66M-2536.**

Whereas the City has entered into a Subdivision Agreement with Laurier Homes (Keeler) Inc., to provide for the public highways and municipal services on Plan 66M-2536 and all affected City Divisions have no objection to the City of Toronto's intention to assume the municipal services installed pursuant to the Subdivision Agreement;
