BY-LAW 229-2026

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting
 Memory Lane and Queen Street East.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in
 alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Memory Lane	Both	A point 110 metres east of Leslie Street and a point 40 metres further east	Anytime
Queen Street East	South	A point 62.3 metres east of Logan Avenue and a point 92 metres east of Leslie Street	4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays
Queen Street East	South	A point 92 metres east of Leslie Street and a point 55 metres further east	Anytime
Queen Street East	South	A point 147 metres east of Leslie Street and Eastern Avenue	4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays

B. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Queen Street East	South	A point 62.3 metres east of Logan Avenue and Laing Street	4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays

C. By inserting in Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Queen Street East	South	A point opposite Jones Avenue and Coxwell Avenue	8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri.; 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Sat.	2 hours
