BY-LAW 246-2026

To amend By-law 1108-2025, respecting the amendment of City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 545, Licensing and Chapter 441, Fees and Charges to delete or amend certain licensing requirements, to correct minor technical errors.

Whereas on October 9, 2025, Council adopted By-law 1108-2025 to amend Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 545, Licensing and Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 441, Fees and Charges; and

Whereas, by inadvertence, By-law 1108-2025 contained minor errors in three section numbers and omitted to include a section for deletion as previously authorized by Council; and

Whereas under Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 169, Officials, City, the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, may submit bills directly to Council where an action is authorized by Council and to make technical amendments to by-laws to correct technical errors;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. By-law No. 1108-2025 is amended by:
 - A. Deleting §545-13(10) from Clause 1.A and replacing it with §545-13A(10).
 - B. Deleting §545-13(11) from Clause 1.A and replacing it with §545-13A(11).
 - C. Deleting §545-208L from Clause 1.A.
 - D. Adding §545-13A(12)(b) to Clause 1.A.
3. This by-law shall come into force on the date it is passed.
