BY-LAW 256-2026

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Leslie Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Leslie Street	East	Eastern Avenue and Queen Street East	4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays

B. By inserting in Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Leslie Street	East	Eastern Avenue and Memory Lane	4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Fri., except public holidays

C. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Leslie Street	East	Queen Street East and Memory Lane	Anytime
