BY-LAW 264-2026

To appoint an Interim Deputy City Manager, Infrastructure Services, and to repeal By-laws 586-2023 and 1098-2022.

Whereas under section 226.3, 226.4(1) and 226.4(2) of the City of Toronto Act, 2006, the Mayor may appoint a chief administrative officer, may hire and dismiss a head of any division or the head of any other part of the City's organizational structure, and may determine the organizational structure of the City; and

Whereas the authority to appoint Deputy City Managers was delegated to City Council by Mayoral Decision 6-2023;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. David Jollimore is appointed Interim Deputy City Manager, Infrastructure Services, and shall have those duties and responsibilities of the City Manager as may be assigned by the City Manager or Council from time to time.
2. This by-law comes into effect on April 3, 2026.
3. On the date this by-law comes into force, By-laws 586-2023 and 1098-2022 are repealed.
