## **CITY OF TORONTO**

### **BY-LAW 270-2026**

#### **To appoint Dr. Shima Shakory as Associate Medical Officer of Health for the City of Toronto Health Unit.**

Whereas the function of appointing Associate Medical Officers of Health is delegated to Council pursuant to the *City of Toronto Act, 2006*; and

Whereas the Board of Health recommended the appointment of Dr. Shima Shakory as Associate Medical Officer of Health for the City of Toronto Health Unit on February 23, 2026; and

Whereas City Council approved the appointment of Dr. Shima Shakory as Associate Medical Officer of Health for the City of Toronto Health Unit on March 25, 2026; and

Whereas the *Health Protection and Promotion Act* provides that no one is eligible for appointment as Associate Medical Officer of Health unless the Minister of Health and Long-Term Care approves the appointment;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Dr. Shima Shakory is appointed an Associate Medical Officer of Health for the City of Toronto Health Unit, effective immediately, or on the date the appointment is approved by the Ontario Minister of Health and Long-Term Care, whichever is later.
