BY-LAW 312-2026

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Gladstone Avenue.

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
- A. By deleting from Schedule XII (Permitted Angle Parking) in § 950-1311, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)
Gladstone Avenue	West	Bloor Street West and the first lane north of Bloor Street West

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- B. By inserting in Schedule XII (Permitted Angle Parking) in § 950-1311, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)
Gladstone Avenue	West	A point 12 metres north of Bloor Street West and a point 22 metres further north

C. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Gladstone Avenue	East	Bloor Street West and a point 45 meters north	Anytime
Gladstone Avenue	West	A point 34 metres north of Bloor Street West and a point 14 meters further north	Anytime
Gladstone Avenue	West	Bloor Street West and a point 12 meters north	Anytime

D. By inserting in Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Gladstone Avenue	East	A point 45 meters north of Bloor Street West and Shanly Street	10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.	1 hour
