BY-LAW 677-2026

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Morrish Road.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

**A. By deleting from Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in
alphabetical order by street name:**

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Morrish Road	West	Kingston Road and Old Kingston Road	Anytime

**B. By inserting in Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical
order by street name:**

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Morrish Road	West	A point 53 metres north of Kingston Road and Old Kingston Road	Anytime

C. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Morrish Road	West	Kingston Road and a point 53 metres north	Anytime
