BY-LAW 680-2026

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Orton Park Road.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical
order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Orton Park Road	East	A point 119 metres south of Brimorton Drive and a point 13 metres further south	Mon. to Fri.

B. By inserting in Schedule XXIII (Prohibited Turns) in § 950-1322, the following in
alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway)	(In Column 2 Direction)	(In Column 3 Turns Prohibited)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)
Orton Park Road, between Merkley Square and Ladysbridge Drive (north intersection)	Northbound and Southbound	U-Turns	Anytime
Orton Park Road and the driveway access at No. 125 Orton Park Road, located on the east side of Orton Park Road, opposite Brimorton Drive	Westbound	Left	Anytime

C. By inserting in Schedule XXIV (Compulsory Turns) in § 950-1323, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway Being Entered)	(In Column 2 Highway from which Vehicle Enters)	(In Column 3 Highway Not To Be Entered)
Orton Park Road	Driveway access at No. 125 Orton Park Road, located on the east side of Orton Park Road, opposite Brimorton Drive	Brimorton Drive
