## **CITY OF TORONTO**

### **BY-LAW 918-2026**

#### **To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Corinthian Boulevard.**

The Scarborough Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XXXV (Speed Limits on Public Highways) in § 950-1334, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

B. By inserting in Schedule XXXV (Speed Limits on Public Highways) in § 950-1334, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

|-----------------------------|----------------------------------------------------------------------------------|----------------------------------------|
| Corinthian Boulevard        | Pharmacy Avenue (north intersection) and<br>Pharmacy Avenue (south intersection) | 30                                     |

C. By inserting in Schedule XL (Highways With Traffic Calming Measures) in § 950-1339, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| Corinthian Boulevard        | Pharmacy Avenue (south intersection) and Fairglen Avenue |
