CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 1123-2026

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, respecting Brimorton Drive.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes, and Cycle Tracks, is amended as follows:

- A. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Brimorton Drive	Scarborough Golf Club Road and a point 35 metres east	Southerly Eastbound and Northerly Westbound	Anytime

- B. By inserting in Schedule E (Cycle Tracks) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Scarborough Golf Club Road	Confederation Drive and Lawrence Avenue East	Easterly Northbound and Westerly Southbound	Anytime
Scarborough Golf Club Road	Lawrence Avenue East and Ellesmere Road	Easterly Northbound	Anytime
Scarborough Golf Club Road	Lawrence Avenue East and Par Avenue	Westerly Southbound	Anytime

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(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times or Days)
Scarborough Golf Club Road	Lawrence Avenue East and Par Avenue	Westerly Northbound lane adjacent to the westerly southbound cycle track	Anytime
Scarborough Golf Club Road	Par Avenue and a point 170 metres south of Ellesmere Road	Westerly Southbound	Anytime
Scarborough Golf Club Road	A point 170 metres south of Ellesmere Road and Ellesmere Road	Westerly Southbound	Anytime
Scarborough Golf Club Road	A point 170 metres south of Ellesmere Road and Ellesmere Road	Westerly Northbound lane adjacent to the westerly southbound cycle track	Anytime
