CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 1215-2026

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 937, Temporary Closing of Highways and Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, in respect of Traffic and Parking Measures during Council recess.

The Council of the City of Toronto Council enacts:

1. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 937, Temporary Closing of Highways, is amended as follows:

- A. Adding §937-3.49 as follows:

§937-3.49. Closures during Council recess

Despite any other by-law, until the end of the day on January 31, 2027, the General Manager, Transportation Services of the City of Toronto may temporarily close to vehicular and pedestrian traffic any highway or portion of a highway, as required for the purposes of managing traffic movement, to accommodate construction or development, or to address public safety or the safety of any property.

2. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

- A. Adding §950-408 as follows:

§950-408 Temporary Parking, Stopping and Standing Restrictions for Street Work and Temporary Street Occupations

Despite any other by-law, where temporary signs approved by the General Manager have been posted, no person shall park, stop or stand a vehicle on a highway alongside, across from or in the vicinity of any permitted street work or temporary street occupation.

Enacted and passed on July 30, 2026.
