MAYORAL DECISION 6-2023

To rescind Mayoral Decision 11-2022 and delegate certain powers under Part VI.1 of the City of Toronto Act to City Council and the City Manager

The Mayor has decided as follows:

A. Rescinding of Mayoral Decision 11-2022:

1. Mayoral Decision 11-2022 is rescinded.

B. Delegation to City Council to hire and dismiss the Chief Administrative Officer:

1. The power assigned to the Mayor to appoint a chief administrative officer under section 226.3 of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006* is delegated to City Council.

C. Delegation to City Manager and City Council to hire and dismiss certain City officials:

1. The power of the Mayor to hire or dismiss a head of any division or the head of any other part of the organizational structure under subsection 226.4(2) of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006* is delegated to the City Manager except for the following positions, which are delegated to City Council:

- a. Deputy City Managers; and
- b. City Solicitor

2. The City Manager may sub-delegate the authority in section C(1) to a City official in writing.

D. Delegation to the City Manager the powers to determine the organizational structure of the City:

1. The power of the Mayor to determine the organizational structure of the City under subsection 226.4(1) of the *City of Toronto Act, 2006* is delegated to the City Manager.

2. The City Manager may sub-delegate the authority in D(1) to a City official in writing.
