**Re: Liquor Licence - Royal Canadian Legion, Centennial Branch 614 (100 Salome Drive)**

Recently I was advised that the Royal Canadian, Centennial Branch 614 (100 Salome Drive) will be holding their Annual Parade and Military Tattoo on August 15, 2010. As in previous years, the Legion is seeking to extend its liquor licence to include an outdoor beer garden on their property.

Given that this liquor licence application requires approval by Scarborough Community Council and City Council, I would ask that this item be added to the agenda for the May 25, 2010 meeting of Scarborough Community Council with the following recommendation:

**“Scarborough Community Council recommends the declaration, for liquor licensing purposes, of the “Royal Canadian Legion Annual Parade and Military Tattoo” to be held on August 15, 2010, from 11:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. at the Royal Canadian Legion Centennial Branch 614, 100 Salome Drive, as an event of municipal and/or community significance and advise the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario that it has no objection to the extension of their existing license to allow for an outside beer garden.”**
