I am pleased to transmit and recommend adoption of the attached report from the Chair of the Corporations Nominating Panel containing the Panel's recommendations for the appointment of citizens to the Board of Directors of the Toronto Community Housing Corporation.

The Public Appointments Policy adopted by Council in September, 2006 and amended on April 12, 2011 (Item EX4.7) provides that a Corporations Nominating Panel be appointed by the Mayor to identify, recruit and recommend candidates to be considered by Council for the Boards of Directors of City-owned corporations.

The following persons were named to the Panel to recommend candidates for the TCHC Board: Councillor Paul Ainslie; Mary L. Flynn-Guglietti (solicitor with a practice in administrative law, with an emphasis on municipal, land use planning and environmental law) and Bahadur Madhani (president and owner of a property management and real estate syndications company and former Chair and current member of the Board of the YMCA of Greater Toronto and member of the Toronto City Summit Alliance Steering Committee).

I want to personally, and on behalf of City Council, thank the Panel, and particularly Ms. Flynn-Guglietti and Mr. Madhani, for their participation in the recruitment process and for working to help the City meet its governance and diversity objectives.
