Dear Colleagues

As you know, a triathlon is a multi discipline endurance race involving the completion of three continuous and sequential endurance legs; swimming, cycling and running. Major cities around the world play host to triathlon events year round. The International Triathlon Union (ITU) was founded in 1989 as the world wide governing body of the sport with the chief goal of putting triathlon on the Olympic program. The sport made its Olympic debut in 2000 and since then its popularity has grown in our country and around the world.

The proposal before council provides the opportunity for a local organization to launch an event in Toronto to showcase this sport. The number of Canadian triathlon athletes training for Olympic berths is growing, but amateur athletes need the support of their communities to help generate interest and promote sponsorship opportunities to achieve these goals.

I am urging members of council to support this triathlon event, the Ironman, in our community. The organizers will sponsor the full costs of the event and once established there will have been an estimated economic benefit to the city of \$1.5 million to \$5 million. This is on top of the focus it would bring to the support for our athletes in training for the 2015 Pan Am and Olympic Games.

It is shortsighted to think that sports events and this event in particular, benefit only the few. It has farreaching economic benefits for our businesses, communities and our local athletes.
