Proposed Non-Residential Customers Properties Billing System and Rate Structure

All rates are effective July 1, 2012.

Non-Residential Billing System and Rate Structure

Notes:

- 1) Collection method and frequency of services will be determined by Chapter 841, Waste Collection, Commercial Properties. Base Service is up to twice a week garbage collection and once per week recycling and organics collection. Premium Organics collection is above the base service for curbside customers (i.e. two, five and six times per week collection will be subject to posted fees). Premium organics service will not be provided to front-end customers.
- 2) Recycling and organics collection is provided at no additional charge to bag, bin, or front-end customers. No other diversion collection services will be provided.
- 3) Fees for eligible Non-Residential Properties (see Appendix C) are effective on July 1, 2012 and will be phased in over four year period for all fees (bin, bag, front-end bulk and bag tag) as follows:
 - Beginning on July 1, 2012 - 25% of the applicable fees set out above will be charged to the eligible Non-Residential Properties;

- Beginning on January 1, 2013 - 50% of the applicable fees set out above will be charged to the eligible Non-Residential Properties;
 - Beginning on January 1, 2014 - 75% of the applicable fees set out above will be charged to the eligible Non-Residential Properties; and
 - Beginning on January 1, 2015 - 100% of the applicable fees for the year fees set out above will be charged to the eligible Non-Residential Properties.
- 4) Eligible Non-Residential properties receiving service via curbside bin will be invoiced quarterly in advance.
 - 5) Eligible Non-Residential properties receiving services via front end collection will be sent a combined Waste and Water Utility Bill setting out the charges owing based on lift information for the period. Utility Bills will be sent out in accordance with Article III of Chapter 849, Water and Sewer Services and Utility Bill.
 - 6) Eligible Non-Residential properties receiving services via curbside bins will be provided with garbage, recycling and organic bins for free. Eligible Non-Residential properties receiving services via front-end Bulk customers must purchase and utilize acceptable bulk containers for garbage, recycling and organics. Bag customers must purchase and utilize specified bag tags for collection of garbage.
 - 7) The above fees are based on a mandatory, all-or-nothing service. That is, eligible Non-Residential Properties must fully participate in the City's diversion programs to receive City waste collection. Similarly, eligible Non-Residential Properties will not be allowed to utilize free City recycling and organics services while contracting private waste collection.
 - 8) Eligible Non-Residential Properties that contain a stationary compactor unit shall ensure that garbage is packed by means of a stationary compactor unit and will be charged the compacted rate for all waste as set out above for front-end collection.
