SUMMARY

This report contains legal advice about an ongoing lawsuit to recover costs incurred as a result of contamination in the Sheppard Avenue West right-of-way adjacent to an Imperial Oil gas station. This report seeks authority respecting the conduct of the lawsuit.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The City Solicitor recommends that:

- 1. City Council adopt the confidential instructions to staff in Attachment 1; and
- 2. In view of the fact that litigation is ongoing, the confidential information and recommendations in Attachment 1 remain confidential until the lawsuit is finally resolved, including all appeals.

DECISION HISTORY

Council authorized the commencement of a lawsuit to recover costs incurred as a result of contaminated soil encountered during the construction of the Don Mills Station on the Sheppard Avenue subway line, by adoption of Clause 9 of Report 5 of the Administration Committee, at its meeting of September 28, 1999.
