## Re: Left-turning prohibitions and right-turning prohibitions at the intersection of Steeles Avenue East at Staines Road

City Council at its meeting of August 2010 approved the installation of weekday AM Peak (6:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.) westbound to southbound left-turn prohibitions and PM Peak (3:00 p.m. to 7:00 pm.) northbound to eastbound right-turning prohibitions at the intersection of Steeles Avenue East and Staines Road for the present time, and not when the Markham By-Pass extension is approved and opens to traffic.

But since the sign went up on Oct.22, 2010 residents/employers/employees are all very unhappy over the installation of the sign and therefore I wish to pass the following motion:

a) Rescind all turn prohibitions at the intersection of Steeles Avenue East and Staines Road.

*b)* Pass or amend the appropriate by-law(s) accordingly.

" c) Direct the General Manager, Transportation Services to remove all existing turn prohibition signs at the intersection of Steeles Avenue East and Staines Road prior to the enactment of the above by-law(s)."
