

# STAFF REPORT ACTION REQUIRED

## Pay and Display Parking Amendments – Huntley Street from Isabella Street to Selby Street Howard Street from Sherbourne Street to Glen Road

### SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which Community Council has been delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services has been requested by the Toronto Parking Authority to report on amending the current pay parking hours of operation on the following streets in order to coordinate with pay parking hours of operation found on streets in the surrounding area:

- Huntley Street, between Selby Street and Isabella Street
- Howard Street, between Sherbourne Street and Glen Road

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that Toronto and East York Community Council:

- 1. Rescind the regulation authorizing the operation of parking machines from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., and from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Monday to Saturday and from 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Sunday for a maximum period of 3 hours at a rate of \$2.00 per hour on the south side of Howard Street between Sherbourne Street and Glen Road.
- 2. Rescind the regulation authorizing the operation of parking machines from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday; from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Saturday; and from 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Sunday for a maximum period of 3 hours at a rate of

\$2.00 per hour on the east side of Huntley Street, from Isabella Street to Selby Street.

- 3. Authorize the operation of parking machines from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., and from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Saturday, and from 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Sunday for a maximum period of 3 hours at a rate of \$2.00 per hour on the south side of Howard Street, from Sherbourne Street to Glen Road.
- 4. Authorize the operation of parking machines from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., and from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Monday to Friday; from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Saturday; and from 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Sunday for a maximum period of 3 hours at a rate of \$2.00 per hour on the east side of Huntley Street, from Isabella Street to Selby Street.

#### **Financial Impact**

The funds to implement this change, estimated at \$500.00 are available in the Toronto Transportation Services 2011 Interim Operating Budget.

#### **DECISION HISTORY**

At its meeting of August 17, 2010, Toronto and East York Community Council approved Item 36.85 entitled "Pay and Display Parking – Various Streets in Wards 27 and 28" authorizing the operation of parking machines on the following streets:

- Earl Place, between Huntley Street and Jarvis Street
- Earl Street, between Huntley Street and Sherbourne Street
- Huntley Street, between Selby Street and Isabella Street
- Isabella Street, between Jarvis Street and Sherbourne Street
- Linden Street, between Huntley Street and Sherbourne Street
- Maitland Place, between Homewood Avenue and Jarvis Street
- Howard Street, between Sherbourne Street and Parliament Street

#### COMMENTS

Subsequently, Transportation Services was requested by Toronto Parking Authority to amend the current pay parking hours of operation on Huntley Street and Howard Street in order to help harmonize the pay parking hours of operation with that of streets found in the surrounding area. Specifically, the operating hours of the parking machines will change to encompass the entire period on Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Howard Street, and that a two hour period from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Monday to Friday will be added on Huntley Street. Permit parking regulations on these streets will not be impacted. There is no transit service on either Huntley Street or Howard Street.
