SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to recommend Board of Management appointments, for the new term of Council, for thirty-six Business Improvement Areas that fall within the Toronto and East York Community Council boundaries. The Toronto and East York Community Council has delegated authority to make final decisions regarding BIA appointments.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director, Business Services recommends that:

- 1. Toronto and East York Community Council appoint the nominees listed in Attachment No. 1 to the Boards of Management for thirty-six Business Improvement Areas (BIAs) for a term expiring at the end of the term of Council or as soon thereafter as successors are appointed.
- 2. Schedule A of the Municipal Code Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, be amended to reflect the changes in the number of members and the number of members required for quorum of each of the BIA Boards of Management.

Financial Impact

There are no financial implications resulting from the adoption of this report.

DECISION HISTORY

Municipal Code Chapter 19 states that the term of BIA Board of Management appointments expire with the term of Council. In an election year, BIAs are required to elect nominees for appointment to the next Board of Management at an Annual General Meeting (AGM).

To date, thirty-six BIAs within the Toronto and East York Community Council area have held Annual General Meetings (AGMs) and elected Boards of Management for the 2011-2014 Council term. Toronto and East York Community Council has authority to appoint these nominees.

The nominees listed in Attachment No. 1 meet the requirements for membership of a BIA Board as set out in Chapter 19 of the Municipal Code.

In some cases, BIAs voted to alter the size of their Board of Management or quorum. Amendments are required to Schedule A of Municipal Code Chapter 19, which prescribes the number of members of each BIA Board of Management and number of members required for quorum.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

There are forty-three BIAs within the geographic area of the Toronto and East York Community Council. To-date, thirty-six have held their 2010 Annual General Meetings (AGMs) to elect members to their Boards of Management. City staff attended each AGM to ensure elections were held in accordance with the Municipal Code. Attachment No. 1 lists the Board of Management nominees and the number of members required for quorum.

Of the remaining seven BIAs, six will elect their new Boards of Management early in 2011. One BIA, Historic Queen East, is inactive.

Council members are appointed to BIA Boards by the Striking Committee.

COMMENTS

In accordance with Municipal Code Chapter 19, thirty-six Business Improvement Areas located within the Toronto and East York Community Council area have elected Board of Management nominees at an Annual General Meeting. It is recommended that Council appoint the Board of Management nominees listed in Attachment No. 1 and approve any amendments required to Schedule A of Municipal Code Chapter 19 concerning the number of members of each Board of Management and quorum.

The nominations to six BIAs in the Toronto and East York Community Council boundaries that did not hold their AGMs in sufficient time to be included in this report will be addressed in subsequent reports.
