Dear Councillor McConnell,

The Young Centre for Performing Arts, which is primarily a performance venue, is located in the Distillery Historic District (55 Mill Street, Building #49, Toronto, ON, M5A 3C4). We are applying for a Stadium Endorsement from the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario that would permit our patrons to bring alcoholic beverages into performances in our Marilyn & Charles Baillie Theatre, Michael Young Theatre and Tank House Theatre, all of which include tiered seating in their standard seating configurations.

As a part of the application process, the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario requires that The Young Centre apply for a Liquor Sales License Stadium Endorsement under The Young Centre's existing liquor license (Venue: 1691521 Ontario Inc., liquor license # 811750). The AGCO requires that a resolution of City Council to allow this endorsement accompany our application package. We are therefore respectfully submitting our formal request to Council for their approval at this time.
