Please accept this as our written notification that the Danforth Business Improvement Area (BIA) will be hosting its 13<sup>th</sup> Annual Charity Road Hockey Challenge on Sunday, May 1, 2011. This event is raising funds for The March of Dimes of Canada.

The City of Toronto Street Events Department is issuing a road closure and sidewalk sale permit for this event. Danforth Avenue will be closed to traffic from Ellerbeck Avenue to Jackman Avenue.

As part of this year's event, the BIA will be organizing a beer and food garden within a section of the road closure (from 259 Danforth Avenue to 279 Danforth Avenue). This area is 100 feet in length and 30 feet wide; it will be tented by Absolute Tent Rentals; and, barricaded by 3 foot high fencing.
