City Council on October 24 and 25, 2011, adopted the following:

City Council direct the Board of Management of the Toronto Zoo as follows:

- Toronto Zoo staff make the necessary arrangements with the Performing Animals
 Welfare Society (PAWS) sanctuary to physically transfer the 3 elephants, Iringa, Toka
 and Thika to its facility in California and to transfer legal ownership to PAWS as soon as
 arrangements can be made by PAWS to safely transport the elephants and permits can
 be obtained.
- Toronto Zoo staff work with the PAWS sanctuary on transport and permit arrangements, with the PAWS sanctuary to have the primary responsibility for the safe and humane transport of the elephants to their facility in California; at their cost, while complying with all applicable laws and standards.
- Parts 1 and 2 above be subject to the legal and financial commitments of PAWS and ZooCheck with respect to their contribution to the costs of the transfers being appropriately documented, to the satisfaction of the City Solicitor and the City Manager.
