Roles and Responsibilities

1.0 Purpose Statement

At City Council's direction, Councillor Ana Bailão is leading a Special Working Group that will seek new partnerships and funding to repair social housing and preserve affordable single-family homes. The purpose of the *Special Working Group* is to create a final report to be submitted to Executive Committee at its September 10, 2012 meeting.

2.0 Primary Objectives

The Special Working Group will have three primary objectives to investigate, make findings and report on:

- 1. The future of the single family homes and residents;
- 2. Meeting the repair needs of Toronto Community Housing;
- 3. The requirements for a new Intergovernmental Strategy.

3.0 <u>Membership</u>

- The *Special Working Group* will be comprised of the Chair, Affordable Housing Committee and up to 4 additional members.
- Membership will include:
 - a. Councillor Ana Bailão, Chair, Affordable Housing Committee
 - b. Bud Purves
 - c. Jim Pimblett
 - d. Alan Redway
- 4.0 Role of the Members
 - 1. Attending meetings over the period of April to September 2012;
 - 2. Providing input and advice as it relates to a work plan and its implementation;
 - 3. Reviewing and approving a work plan budget;
 - 4. Providing information as it relates to the mandate of the Special Working Group;
 - 5. Attending public consultations, as needed;
 - 6. Attending media events, as needed;
 - 7. Providing input for, and approving the final report.

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5.0 Role of the Chair

The Chair of the Special Working Group will be responsible for:

- 1. Chairing meetings of the Special Working Group;
- 2. Liaising and meeting with the Mayor, Toronto Community Housing and other key stakeholders;
- 3. Acting as spokesperson for the Special Working Group;
- 4. Hosting public consultations.

6.0 City Staff Support

- 1. Project management will be provided by the Affordable Housing Office in partnership with Shelter, Support and Housing Administration, Toronto Community Housing and other City Divisions.
- 2. A staff project team will be established to support the work of the Special Working Group consisting of:
 - a. Affordable Housing Office
 - b. City Manager's Office
 - c. Office of the Deputy City Manager and Chief Financial Officer
 - d. Shelter, Support & Housing Administration
 - e. Social Development, Finance & Administration
 - f. Strategic & Corporate Policy
 - g. Toronto Community Housing
 - h. Other City Divisions, as needed
