Appointment of Deputy Chief Building Official - by Councillor Peter Milczyn, seconded by Councillor Ana Bailão

Recommendations

Councillor Peter Milczyn, seconded by Councillor Ana Bailão, recommends that:

- 1. City Council appoint Mario M. Angelucci as a Deputy Chief Building Official for the City of Toronto, with all the powers and duties of the Chief Building Official within the district of the City of Toronto assigned by the Chief Building Official.
- 2. City Council rescind the appointment of James K. Laughlin as Deputy Chief Building Official for the City of Toronto effective immediately.
- 3. City Council authorize and direct the appropriate City officials to take the necessary action to give effect to this appointment including the introduction in Council of any necessary bills.

Summary

James K. Laughlin has resigned from the position of Director and Deputy Chief Building Official effective December 31, 2011 and Mario M. Angelucci has been confirmed in the position of Director, Toronto Building permanently. This Motion is to appoint Mario M. Angelucci as a Deputy Chief Building Official in the City of Toronto.

Subsection 3(2) of the Building Code Act, 1992, requires the council of each municipality to appoint a Chief Building Official and under section 77 of the Legislation Act, 2006 words directing the appointment of a public officer to administer an Act also include the power of appointing a deputy to have all the powers and authority of the public officer or such limited powers and authority as the instrument appointing him or her prescribes. Under By-law No. 443-2002, James K. Laughlin was appointed as a Deputy Chief Building Official for the City of Toronto.
