Tennis Canada will once again be producing the Rogers Cup Tennis Tournament August 4 – 13, 2012 at the Rexall Centre at York University.

Due to the upcoming changes to the AGCO's Liquor laws that come into effect on July 1, 2012, we are submitting a Temporary Extension Application to cover our full site (please see attached site plan) that is enclosed by 6' high steel security fencing. Our current licence includes designated areas that are within our full site as noted on the plan. The service hours of 11am through to 12 midnight would not change

As part of our application to the AGCO we are required to submit a letter of non-objection that is issued by the Municipal Clerk stating that there is no objection to the extension of the proposed extended licence area. A similar letter is required from our landlord, York University, which is attached for your reference.
