Notice of Motion – MM 26.9 – On April 25, 2012, GMC adopted the results of PF&R's Request for Proposal for the Operation and Maintenance of Food & Beverage Concessions at various PF&R locations. On May 8, 2012, Council considered this item and cancelled the RFP, directing PF&R to re-issue an RFP for all locations excluding East York Arena and L'Amoreaux Sports Centre. Council also requested PF&R and PMMD to develop a new strategy that will support community groups to operate food concessions on City facilities; and report to GMC prior to issuing the next RFP. The policy report is expected for November GMC and PF&R will issue another RFP around January 2013. If this motion is approved by Council, it could result in a re-negotiation of the financial terms and conditions in the original RFP.
