## Recommendations

In recognition of the significant storm damage in New York City resulting from Hurricane Sandy, City Council request the City Manager to offer City of Toronto aid to New York City and other appropriate jurisdictions and coordinate the City's response of all emergency services and other divisions, and agencies including Toronto Hydro and Toronto Transit Commission, as necessary.

## Summary

The City of New York has suffered devastating damage due to Hurricane Sandy. The City of Toronto has a proud history of offering emergency aid to other Cities in these cases. The City Manager should be requested to co-ordinate a response among the City's agencies to offer aid to New York City and other appropriate jurisdictions.
