#### Overview

- Ontario retailers were supportive of maintaining the five cent plastic bag fee
- Plastic bag usage was down over 70% in the City of Toronto as of 2011





# Implementation Timeframe

- Retailers need 9 -12 months to successfully implement the ban:
- -3-4 months to deplete bag inventory
- -3-4 months to source new bags
- 3 months to re-configure point of sale work stations (at a | significant cost for retailers)
- Train staff and address potential health and safety issues
