Re: Request for Endorsement of Events for Liquor Licensing Purposes
Royal Canadian Legion, Oakridge Branch 73

I was recently contacted by the Royal Canadian legion, Oakridge Branch 73 advising that they will be hosting the following events:

- Monday, August 6th (Civic Holiday)
Community BBQ from 12:00 pm to 10:00 pm
- Saturday, August 18th (Warriors Day)
Community BBQ from 12:00 to 10:00 pm
- Monday, September 3rd (Labour Day Community)
Community BBQ from 12:00 pm to 10:00 pm

As part of these events, the Legion plans to secure an extension to their existing liquor licence in order to permit the use of the rear portion of their parking lot, as in previous years.
