Dear Mayor Ford:

I am writing to seek nominations from the City of Toronto for a member to sit on the Board of Directors of the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC).

MPAC delivers property assessment services on behalf of Ontario's municipalities. The corporation is governed by a 15-member Board of Directors, all of whom are appointed by the Minister of Finance. The Board is comprised of eight municipal representatives, five persons representing the interests of taxpayers, and two persons representing the interests of the Province.

The MPAC Board has benefited in the past from the inclusion of representatives from the City of Toronto. The position that was formerly occupied by a representative from Toronto is vacant. Recognizing the significant contribution that Toronto makes to MPAC, we would appreciate receiving a list of nominees for a candidate to fill this vacancy on MPAC's Board.

To be eligible to sit on the Board as a municipal representative, a person must be an elected official of a municipality or an officer or employee of a municipality, as provided under section 3 of the *Municipal Property Assessment Corporation Act, 1997*. The regular term of office for board members is three years, and board members may serve for a maximum of two terms.
