# Parking Amendments – Rusholme Park Crescent

#### SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting authority to amend the parking regulations on Rusholme Park Crescent to prohibit parking in the vicinity of the driveway to No. 36 Rusholme Park Crescent.

### RECOMMENDATIONS

**Transportation Services recommends that Toronto and East York Community Council:** 

- 1. Rescind the "No Parking Each Thursday, April 1<sup>st</sup> to November 30<sup>th</sup>" regulation, on the east side of Rusholme Park Crescent between College Street and the south end of Rusholme Park Crescent.
- 2. Approve implementation of a "No Parking Anytime" regulation on the east side of Rusholme Park Crescent from a point 39 metres south of College Street to a point 42.5 metres further south.
- 3. Approve implementation of a "No Parking Each Thursday, April 1<sup>st</sup> to November 30<sup>th</sup>" regulation, on the east side of Rusholme Park Crescent between College Street and a point 39 metres further south.
- 4. Approve implementation of a "No Parking Each Thursday, April 1<sup>st</sup> to November 30<sup>th</sup>" regulation, on the east side of Rusholme Park Crescent between a point 81.5 metres south of College Street and the south end of Rusholme Park Crescent.

#### **Financial Impact**

Funds to undertake the necessary signage adjustments in the estimated amount of \$500.00 are contained within Transportation Services 2012 Interim Operating Budget.

#### **ISSUE BACKGROUND**

Transportation Services has investigated a request from Councillor Ana Bailão, on behalf of residents of No. 36 Rusholme Park Crescent, to prohibit parking in the vicinity of the driveway serving their multi-unit residential complex. They are concerned with the visibility of oncoming traffic for exiting motorists.

### COMMENTS

Rusholme Park Crescent is a local road operating two-way on a road width of 7.3 metres with a speed limit of 40 km/h. Parking is currently permitted on the east side of Rusholme Park Crescent for a maximum period of 3 hours except Thursdays between April 1<sup>st</sup> and November 30<sup>th</sup> when it alternates to the west side of the street. Permit parking is in effect between the hours of 12:01 a.m. and 7:00 a.m.. There is no TTC service on this section of Rusholme Park Crescent.

The adoption of the recommendations listed above will result in the loss of one on-street parking space.
