Re: Request to evaluate the property at 296 Broadview Avenue for inclusion on the City of Toronto Inventory of Heritage Properties

The Zion Congregational Church at 296 Broadview Avenue was constructed in 1894. The church was designed by the firm of the prominent Edward James Lennox or by Lennox himself. Lennox was also the architect of "Old" Toronto City Hall and Casa Loma. It is purported to be one of only three Lennox structures in Riverdale, and the only one that is not protected. I am requesting that Heritage Preservation Services review the property for inclusion on the inventory of heritage properties.

Recommendations:

- 1) Request the Acting Director, Policy and Research, to evaluate and report on the possibility of including the Property at 296 Broadview Avenue on the City of Toronto Inventory of Heritage Properties.
