Amendment of Parking Regulations – Woodington Avenue

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting approval from Toronto and East York Community Council to amend the parking regulations on Woodington Avenue between Sammon Avenue and Milverton Boulevard in order to provide consistency from one block to another.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that Toronto and East York Community Council:

1. Rescind alternate side parking on Woodington Avenue, between Spingdale Boulevard and 38 metres south of Springdale Boulevard;
2. Allow parking for a maximum period of one hour from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on both sides Woodington Avenue, between Spingdale Boulevard and 38 metres south of Springdale Boulevard;
3. Extend the overnight on-street permit parking hours of operation on both sides of Woodington Avenue, between Sammon Avenue and Springdale Boulevard, from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., 7 days a week to 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., 7 days a week

4. Allow parking for a maximum period of one hour from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, during the months of January, February, March, April, June, August, October and December on the east side of Woodington Avenue, between Sammon Avenue and Springdale Boulevard; and
5. Allow parking for a maximum period of one hour from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, during the months May, July, September and November on the west side of Woodington Avenue, between Sammon Avenue and Springdale Boulevard.

Financial Impact

The amount of \$600.00 is available within the current Toronto Transportation Services 2012 Operating Budget.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

A request was received from Councillor Janet Davis, on behalf of area residents, to extend the overnight on-street permit parking hours on Woodington Avenue, between Sammon Avenue and Springdale Avenue, from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., 7 days a week to 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

The Councillor further requested 1 hour maximum parking from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, on Woodington Avenue, from a point 38 metres south of Springdale Boulevard to Sammon Avenue and to amend the current alternate side parking to double sided parking on Woodington Avenue, between Springdale Avenue and a point 38 metres south of Springdale Avenue.

COMMENTS

Woodington Avenue, between Sammon Avenue and Milverton Boulevard, is a local street operating in a two-way north/south bound direction, on a pavement width of 8.5 metres. There is no TTC service on Woodington Avenue.

Parking is currently allowed on an alternate side basis from a point 38 metres south of Springdale Boulevard to Sammon Avenue with 3 hour maximum parking at all other times.

Parking is provided on both sides of the street on Woodington Avenue, between Milverton Boulevard and a point 38 metres south of Springdale Boulevard with a 1 hour maximum parking limit from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday.

Permit parking is in effect on Woodington Ave, between Milverton Boulevard and Springdale Avenue, under the operating hours of 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., 7 days a week. The section of Woodington Avenue, between Springdale Avenue and Sammon Avenue, has permit parking in effect from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

Amending the parking regulations on Woodington Avenue, between Sammon Avenue and Milverton Avenue will provide consistency and reduce confusion for residents, visitors and parking enforcement officers.
