

Introduction of Overnight On-Street Permit Parking – Shuter Street

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting approval from Toronto and East York Community Council to introduce overnight on-street permit parking on the south side of Shuter Street, between Sumach Street and a point 89.2 metres further east, on an area basis, within permit parking area 7C, under the operating hours of 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

Area residents requested the implementation of overnight on-street permit parking on the south side of Shuter Street, between Sumach Street and a point 89.2 metres further east, to accommodate their long term parking needs without being subject to tagging by Parking Enforcement Officers.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize the amendment of Schedule 'A' of Municipal Code Chapter 925 to incorporate the south side of Shuter Street, between Sumach Street and a point 89.2 metres further east, on an area basis,

within permit parking area 7C, under the operating hours of 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

Financial Impact

The amount of \$200.00 is available within the current Toronto Transportation Services 2012 Operating Budget.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

A request was received from Councillor Pam McConnell, on behalf of area residents for the introduction of overnight on-street permit parking on the south side of Shuter Street, between Sumach Street and a point 89.2 metres further east, on an area basis, within permit parking area 7C, under the operating hours of 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

COMMENTS

Shuter Street, between Sumach Street and a point of 89.2 metres further east is a local roadway operating in a two-way east/westbound direction with a pavement width of 14 metres. There is no TTC service on Shuter Street. Parking is allowed on the south side of the street for a maximum period of three hours. Parking is prohibited at anytime on the north side of the street.

Under the provisions of the Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, we are required to conduct a poll of the residents to determine if there is support to introduce permit parking.

Ballots were mailed on June 1, 2012, with the last day for filing a response being July 3, 2012. The results of the poll are as follows:

A field survey has determined that there are sixteen (16) potential on-street parking spaces available on the south side of Shuter Street, between Sumach Street and a point 89.2 metres further east.

The majority of area residents returned their ballots in favour of the introduction of overnight on-street permit parking on Shuter Street, between Sumach Street and a point of 89.2 metres further east to accommodate their long term need for on-street parking.
