RE: NOTIFICATION OF PADDLE THE DON EVENT - SUNDAY, MAY 6, 2012

The Don Watershed Regeneration Council and Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA) are holding the annual Paddle the Don event on Sunday, May 6, 2012. The take-out point for canoes and kayaks is 170 Villiers Street, Toronto.

This event is for invited guest, but there may be a minimal amount of walk-in traffic. TRCA expects approximately 500-700 people to attend. The event will include a BBQ and refreshments, informative displays and a beer tent where the Black Creek Historic Brewery will be selling beer. Black Creek Historic Brewery is an operation of Toronto and Region Conservation, in partnership with Trafalgar Ales and Meads. Black Creek beer will be available for purchase by participants. A designated outdoor area for alcohol consumption will be provided and an application has been made to the Alcohol and Gaming Commission Office for a Public (Sale) Special Occasion Permit to provide alcohol between the hours of 12:00 pm to 4:30 pm. Toronto Port Lands Company has provided approval for the licensed event.

Please be advised that the following steps will be taken to ensure a safe and enjoyable event:

- A vendor will be on site to provide an adequate supply of food and non-alcoholic beverages for purchase by persons attending the event.
- A water filling station will be available.
- Coffee and hot chocolate will be provided free of charge.
- The permit location will be clearly defined and partitioned from unlicensed areas by a minimum 36" high partition.
- All entrance monitors and people serving alcohol, will be Smart Serve trained.
- No more than two alcoholic drinks will be served to any one person at any one time.
- All beverages will be served in disposal cups.
- No persons under the age of 19 years will be permitted in the licensed area.
- No alcohol will be provided to anyone who appears to be intoxicated.
- Appropriate signage concerning the rules of the event will be posted at the entrance to the permitted area.
- A certificate of insurance for a minimum of \$2,000,000 per occurrence will be issued and the City of Toronto and TEDCO will be identified as an additional insured for the day.
- Any and all required permits from the Building Department for the beer tent will be obtained.

Enclosed is a detailed sketch showing the dimensions of the area for which the permit will apply.

The approximate area for which the permit will apply is 1,500 ft² allowing for a maximum capacity of 125 people. Of this area, 1,000 ft² will be within a tent with 3 sides with walls, and 500 ft² will be outside of the tent, within the area fenced with a minimum 36" high barrier.

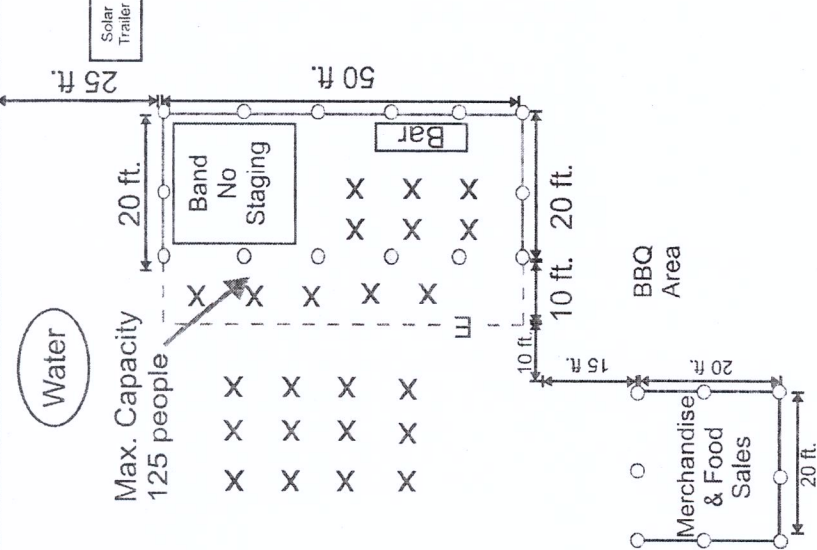

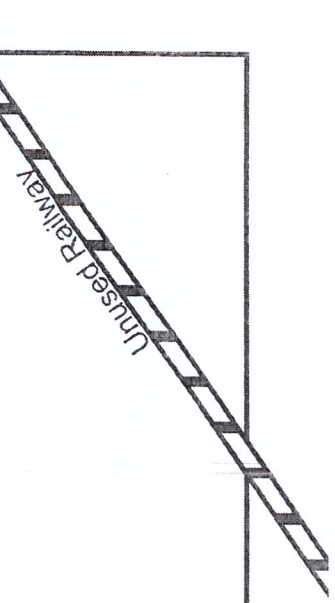


Solar Trailer
