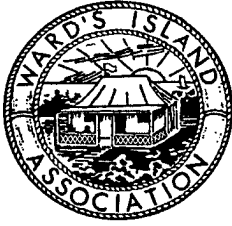

Dear Tom,

The Wards Island Recreation Association is starting preparations for this year's annual Gala Day celebrations. As in previous years, we are requesting a letter from Councillor McConnell's office confirming that Gala Day is a community festival of Municipal Significance.

The Ward's Island Recreation Association is a registered not-for-profit organization established in 1913 to provide its members with access to amateur sport and social events held in and around our heritage clubhouse, built in 1937. When not being used for WIRA member activities, the clubhouse facilities are available for rent by the public for weddings and other events. The WIRA is managed by volunteers from the surrounding communities of Ward's and Algonquin Islands.

Gala Day is a longstanding tradition, a time when present and former Islanders gather at the Wards Island clubhouse. It is held every summer on the August long weekend (August 3-6, 2012), beginning with our annual Fire Parade on Friday evening and continuing throughout the weekend with a Beer Garden on the clubhouse green, a Saturday night dance, adult and youth games, a Children's Midway, a masquerade, tennis and baseball tournaments and Bingo. All events are open to the public, and only the evening events (Bingo and the dance) charge admission.

This year's Gala is particularly notable, since it marks the 75th anniversary of the building of the clubhouse, and will be the kickoff to our centennial year in 2013. As part of the festivities we are unveiling our new Pebble Mosaic, a work of public art created by a team of more than 50 community volunteers. The Pebble Mosaic is Phase I of the Willow Square project which will eventually include restoration of the historic Landing Stage, an undertaking in partnership with the Toronto Parks Department. We are very excited to introduce Island visitors to this beautiful new space at Gala Day 2012.
