# **City Council Decision**

City Council on April 10 and 11, 2012, adopted the following:

- 1. City Council amend the composition of the Larry Grossman Forest Hill Memorial Arena Board of Management by increasing the number of public members from 5 residents to 7 residents, being one additional at-large member and one of whom may be nominated by the Forest Hill Hockey Association.
- 2. City Council direct the City Clerk to request the Larry Grossman Forest Hill Memorial Arena Board of Management to solicit and submit an interest group nomination from the Forest Hill Hockey Association to the North York Community Council Arena Board Nominating Panel for consideration and recommendation of an appointment to the Larry Grossman Forest Hill Memorial Arena Board of Management.
- 3. City Council direct the North York Community Council Arena Board Nominating Panel to also recommend an additional at-large candidate to the North York Community Council for appointment to the Larry Grossman Forest Hill Memorial Arena Board of Management.

#### Summary

The Arena Board of Management would benefit from additional members. The current composition of the Larry Grossman Forest Hill Memorial Arena Board of Management is 2 Councillors and 5 residents. Increasing the composition from 5 residents to 7 residents, one additional at-large member would allow for further valued participation from the community and one of whom may be nominated by the Forest Hill Hockey Association, would facilitate input from this important user group.
