

campaign is to persuade the federal and provincial governments to renew their housing partnership and properly fund social housing.


A two-year campaign to secure 1/3 of funding from all levels of government.

3 KEY OBJECTIVES

- 1. The federal government to stop withdrawing money for social housing and instead reinvest that money back into social housing capital repairs.
- 2. The provincial government to treat social housing providers fairly when paying social assistance rent rates.
- 3. The federal and provincial governments to provide fully funded, long-term housing strategies.


