CONTENTS OF THE PROPOSAL TO RELOCATE A BINGO HALL

2. A copy of our current Certificate of Registration as a Gaming Supplier is attached at end in the Appendix.

3. Attached below is the map of 5601 Steeles Ave West. New location is identified as (A).



Listed below are all the halls within a 30km radius of this relocation.

- a) Delta Bingo Downsview, 1868 Wilson Avenue, North York.
- b) Delta Bingo St. Clair, 1799 St. Clair Avenue West, Toronto
- c) Rutherford Bingo, 291 Rutherford Road, Brampton
- d) Meadowvale Bingo, 2295 Battleford Rd South, Mississauga
- e) Bingo World Richmond Hill, 350 Newkirk Road, Richmond Hill

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4. A description of the new hall explaining how the new hall differs from the old hall.

i. Prize boards will be determined based on market demographics and spending habits upon opening. Programs currently in place will be implemented in the beginning, as follows:

The prize board per non-peak sessions at 1pm, 4pm & 10pm:

- \$3250 guaranteed prize board with 4 variable “specials” games at \$1,000 (Early Bird), \$3,000 (Super Jackpot), \$3,000 (Progressive) and \$5,000 (Bonanza) with two variable “side” games at \$2500 (Jackpot Balls break open tickets) and \$5,000 (8-ball game).
- book prices will be \$2 per strip.
- verifier prices are \$18 for two regular books, with \$30, 40, 50 packages including specials.

The prize board per peak evening sessions at 7pm:

- \$6250 guaranteed prize board with 4 variable “specials” games at \$1,000 (Early Bird), \$3,000 (Super Jackpot), \$3,000 (Progressive) and \$5,000 (Bonanza) with two variable “side” games at \$2500 (Jackpot Balls break open tickets) and \$5,000 (8-ball game).
- book prices will be \$20 per 6-strip, \$18-5, \$12-3 and \$5 for single books.
- verifier prices are \$18 for two regular books, with \$15, 25, 35 packages including specials.

ii. There will be 4 sessions daily at 1, 4, 7, and 10pm totalling 28 per week. Current total is also 28.

iii. Book prices have been outlined above.

iv. The seating capacity in new hall is 450 people. Current capacity is 300.

v. Estimated attendance by session is 150-200 (100-150 currently) during afternoon sessions and 250-350 (200-250 currently) during evening sessions.

vi. Estimated spend per player per session is \$70-75. Currently \$60-65.

- vii. Estimated profits for charities per month is \$150,000.
- viii. Operating costs per month are \$110,000 and profits per month are \$20-30,000.
- ix. The customer base will be drawn from Etobicoke, Vaughan, Markham, York and Richmond Hill.
- x. Ancillary functions will include a snack bar, toy machines and bank machines.

8. Summary outlining reasons as to why this relocation should be approved with benefits to the community is outlined below.

- the most important factor to our relocation is that we will be moving further away from our two closest competitors, Delta St. Clair and Delta Downsview into an area where there are no other bingo halls within close proximity.

- In turn we expect to have a much bigger market to draw from which will lead to higher profits for the charities that are involved.

- we are currently sandwiched in between two Delta bingo halls and aggressively compete with each other for the greatest share of our customer market. By moving away from our competitors into a region we can call our own, we will be able to design our programs and prices to meet

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maximum profit potential for our Charity Organization without having any competitor close by to influence the market. We can dictate this market ourselves.

- the higher the profits the more the charities stand to benefit, which will help further fund the programs they have in place and possibly lead to more.

- lastly, our current lease with *Smart Centres* expires on March 31, 2012 which is forcing us to relocate. We have found a great new location that we are confident will continue to generate great profits to our Charity Organization and for ourselves.

Good afternoon Sandy,

As per our discussion regarding the "Richmond Hill Bingo World" complaint to our relocation plans, here is our response.

To document we had been given notice from Smart Centres a few years ago that our lease would be expiring at 2335 Keele Street on Dec 31, 2011 and would not be renewed.

Considering the logistics involved in finding an ideal building that would be suitable for our business including following protocol with the City of Toronto and the AGCO, past experience indicated that this entire process could take up to a few years to complete. With time not on our side we had therefore asked for any extensions that could generously be given.

We were first given an extension until June 30, 2012. When Smart Centres ran into a few snags on their end they had given us a further extension until Dec 31, 2012, and could negotiate further months if needed. These further months were in fact needed and we had been given a final extension that will end this upcoming March 31, 2013. Unfortunately further extensions are no long possible as Smart Centres finally has their plans in place to renovate our location starting in April, 2013.

In the meantime, we had in the past year sourced the new location at 5601 Steeles Ave and had begun the necessary plans to relocate, starting with the Etobicoke Committee Of Adjustments then continuing with the AGCO Relocation Proposal, the Public Notice, Lease with the new building owner, building permits, contractors etc.

To our understanding our Licence to operate a bingo hall is valid in the jurisdiction of Etobicoke and we had therefore ensured that any new building we would potentially relocate to was within the same area so as to make this process as smooth as possible for us.

As stated to you on the phone, this business is our family's livelihood and has been for the better part of 25 years. With all of these deadlines in the immediate future we were moving on all fronts quicker than we would've liked to ensure the transition from one hall to the next was as seamless as possible and didn't have us out of operation for too long. Any day not in business is critical and weeks/months are killer. With all this in mind we've had to sign a new lease without a formal approval from the City, source contractors that could work round the clock with these deadlines in place, get building permits from the city etc. and hope all could be done in time to re-open in early April. None of this would've been forced/expedited as quickly as they have been if it wasn't for our fast approaching March 31st deadline.

In direct response to the claim that we will be pulling customers in Vaughan away from the Richmond Hill hall, our argument to that is that the Richmond Hill hall is pulling customers from many markets including Markham, Newmarket, Barrie, Vaughan, Woodbridge without much competition at all. Our relocation moves us slightly further north and the impact to their hall would be little at best. Further, our

current location is only 18 kms (all distance measurements taken from Google maps) away from Vaughan so one could argue that our clientelle as it exists already has customers from this area.

We are also currently in a position where 3 halls (Delta St. Clair, Delta Wilson, Ultimate Bingo) are within only 8.3km of each other battling for the same customer base. This is a suffocating marketplace which is impacting all charity organizations and our relocation would significantly ease the pressure (increase profits!!) on all 3 fronts. In comparison, our relocation would still be 23 kms away from the Richmond Hill hall and although a small portion of their Vaughan base would be impacted, they still have all other outlying regions as noted above to pull from. Their argument does not seem to hold much weight when you consider our situation as it exists now. If 3 halls can compete within 8 kms, surely a second hall within 22 kms of Richmond Hill will not pose a problem.

Finally, this is a competitive marketplace and so long as we are not moving into the Richmond Hill area and staying within our own jurisdiction as we are doing, we have as much a right as they do to pull from outlying areas to make a successful bingo hall. Their issue isn't with the Richmond Hill customers, its from Vaughan an area where neither hall is situated.

As stated, this business is our livelihood and the quicker we can get this resolved the better for us and everyone involved regarding our business including staff, charity organizations, all of our suppliers and most importantly our dedicated customers! Please review and let us know if we can provide anything further. I will make myself readily available.

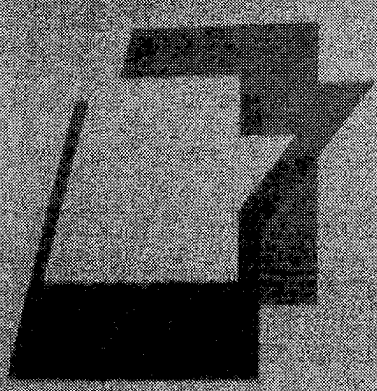
