I am writing to provide you with details regarding adjustments to the financial support that the government committed to your municipality as a result of the phase-out of GTA pooling, as discussed between Ministry staff and members of your staff in parallel with the work of the Provincial Municipal Fiscal and Service Delivery Review (PMFSDR).

In the 2007 Ontario Budget, the government announced a plan to phase out GTA pooling over seven years, beginning in 2007. At that time, the government committed to make provisions to ensure continued financial support for those municipalities that received assistance through GTA pooling.

As you know, an agreement was recently announced through the work of the PMFSDR to upload the costs of all social assistance benefits from municipalities. This upload agreement will have an impact on the determination of financial support that the province had committed to the City of Toronto as a result of the phase-out of GTA pooling.

As discussed, these adjustments have been made in comparison to the City's 2007 pooling revenue, before the phase-out began, and are noted in the table below.
