We are the solicitors for Topper Linen Supply Limited, the owner of the properties municipally known as 2, 6, 20, 22, 26 & 32 Mulock Avenue and 54 Junction Road, in the City of Toronto (the "Properties").

The Properties have not been incorporated into the City-wide Zoning By-law (the "City-wide By-law") at this time. The Properties are represented as a "hole" in the City-wide By-law mapping with the label "Not Part of this By-law" and the former general zoning by-law continues to govern the Properties.

Pursuant to the provisions of the *Planning Act*, in order to preserve one's right to appeal the City-wide By-law to the Ontario Municipal Board, a property owner must express its concerns on the proposed City-wide By-law before Council adopts the New By-law. Since Council can make amendments, without notice, at any time prior to adoption of the City-wide By-law, a property owner must protect its right of appeal by filing a letter expressing concerns with the City-wide By-law.

While our client is satisfied with the Properties represented as a "hole" in the current draft of the City-wide By-law, our client will object to the application of the provisions, maps, overlays, etc. of the City-wide By-law to the Properties which
