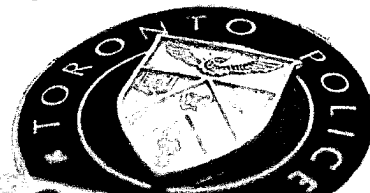

The Toronto Police Service is requesting the public's assistance with the investigation into a fatal collision on Saturday, October 5, 2013.

On Saturday, October 5, 2013 at 7:45 p.m., police responded to a personal injury collision at Finch Avenue West at Goldfinch Court.

It is reported that:

- a 70-year-old man was attempting to cross Finch Avenue West, from the north side to the south side
- a 55-year-old man was operating a 2004 Dodge Caravan, westbound on Finch Avenue West, in the passing lane
- the pedestrian was struck by the vehicle

The pedestrian was taken to hospital with life-threatening injuries. He died in hospital.

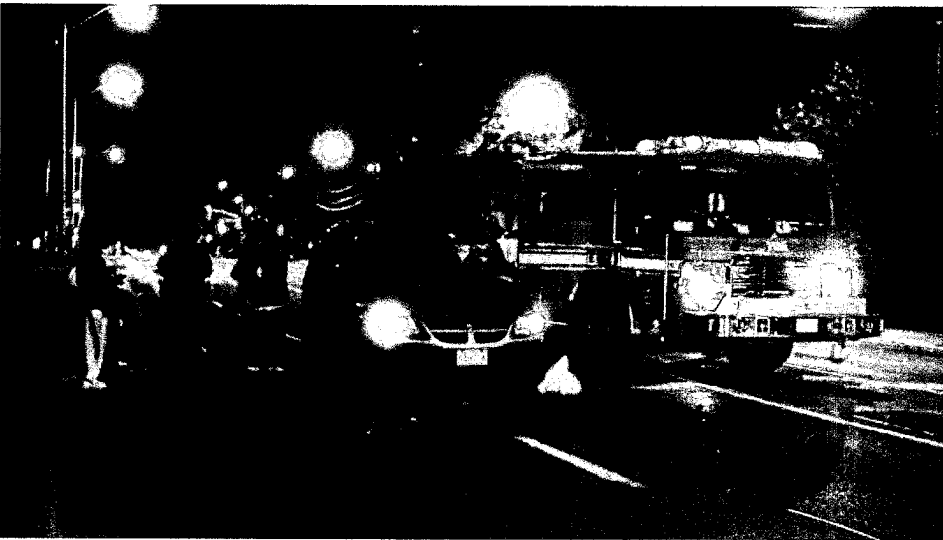

Man dead after being struck by vehicle in North York

A man in his 50s is dead after being struck by a vehicle in North York Saturday evening.

The male pedestrian was struck near Dufferin Street and Finch Avenue around 7:45 p.m., an EMS spokesperson said.

He was rushed to hospital with serious injuries, but was pronounced dead a short time later.

Police have closed down a stretch of Finch Avenue West between Wilmington and Torresdale avenues as they investigate the fatal collision.

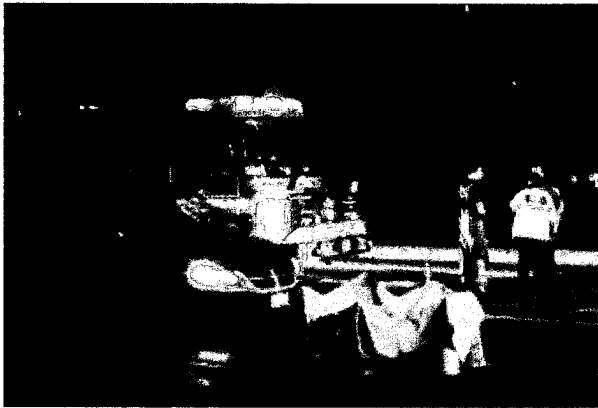

Man dies after crash at Finch and Dufferin

Toronto EMS said the man was taken to Sunnybrook hospital head trauma and fractured leg

A man died in hospital after being struck by a car Saturday night, said Toronto Police.

Toronto EMS said the incident happened before 8 p.m. near the intersection of Finch Ave. E. and Dufferin St.

The man was about 55 years old, and was taken to the local trauma centre of Sunnybrook Hospital with head trauma and a fractured leg, EMS said.

Police are still trying to verify his identity.

Police said they received a call that the car involved was a green minivan, though that has yet to be confirmed by officers on the scene.

The car's occupants, a male driver and his wife, are "traumatized," and are co-operative, police said.

The police reconstruction unit was dispatched at about 9:45 p.m., and investigations are ongoing.

Parts of Finch Ave. were closed for about three hours to accommodate the investigation.
