Re: City of Toronto's School Boards Working Group

At its meeting on May 8, 2013, the Toronto District School Board passed the following Motion:

Whereas, the City of Toronto Council is currently contemplating a motion to create a Toronto School Boards Working Group; and

Whereas, there are numerous issues of common interest and mutual concern between the City of Toronto, the Toronto District School Board, and other school boards in the Toronto area; and

Whereas, it is beneficial to the City of Toronto, the Toronto District School Board, and other City of Toronto area Boards of Education to have a forum where issues of common interest and mutual concern be discussed;

Therefore, be it resolved:

- (a) That a communication be sent to the City of Toronto expressing the Board's support for the creation of a Toronto School Boards Working Group;**
- (b) That upon creation of a Toronto School Boards Working Group by the City of Toronto the Toronto District School Board appoint two Trustees to serve on the working group, and;**
- (c) That the (TDSB) Director make appropriate Board staff support available to the Toronto School Boards Working Group, as required and on an issue-by issue basis.**
