To Mayor Rob Ford and Members of Executive Council:

It has come to our attention that the issue of expanding the BIXI bike program will go before Executive Council for consideration. As a BIA that serves an enthusiastic bike culture, the Kensington Market BIA would like to add its voice to the discussion and support the expansion of this program.

We believe that BIXI would be more successful if there was a wider network of bikes available.
