Recommendations

Councillor Paula Fletcher, seconded by Councillor Mary Fragedakis, recommends that:

- 1. City Council request the Executive Director, Municipal Licensing and Standards to establish a divisional protocol for identifying problem properties, a plan to bring these properties into compliance and to make Councillors aware of the policy.
- 2. City Council request the Executive Director, Municipal Licensing and Standards to report to the Licensing and Standards Committee on the impact dealing with hoarding has on the budget reserves of the division and on options for improving the manner in which the City can reduce instances of hoarding.

Summary

For the most part when a property standards issue is identified by Municipal Licensing and Standards (MLS) staff, the property owner is informed of the issue and ordered to comply with the by-law within a set time frame. This system is effective in most cases, however with some properties, issues go unresolved for months or years on end, draining significant resources from MLS with few results.
