SUMMARY

It is recommended that City Council give exemption to Right to Play International/Influence Marketing's "Scion City Chase" and Canadian Auto Worker's "Labour Day Parade Concert" request to operate a beer/wine garden at their event to be held on Nathan Phillips Square.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Chief Corporate Officer recommends that:

1. City Council grant an exemption to Right to Play International/Influence Marketing and Canadian Auto Workers to operate a beer garden and to serve wine and hard liquor contingent upon the following conditions:
 - a. approval of the A.G.C.O.
 - b. approval of the Medical Officer of Health
 - c. compliance with the City of Toronto's Municipal Alcohol Policy
 - d. receipt of all the necessary permits associated with the production of the event
i.e. building permit, noise by-law extension permit
2. City Council requires that the various events compensate the City of Toronto through the Facilities Management Division for all the City of Toronto costs associated with the event.

Financial Impact

There are no financial implications that result from this report.

DECISION HISTORY

The Economic Development & Culture Division has received an application from Right to Play International/Influence Marketing for "Scion City Chase" and Canadian Auto Workers for "Labour Day Parade Concert" for the use of Nathan Phillips Square on August 10th and September 1st, 2013.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

Municipal Code Chapter 237 "Nathan Phillips Square" prohibits the sale of alcohol on "Nathan Phillips Square" without the approval of Council.

COMMENTS

The various event organizers are requesting permission to operate a tented beer garden and to serve beer, wine and hard liquor in the licensed area. The proceeds of these and other sales will go to their respective non-profit organizations.
