Subject: Request to poll for Traffic Calming Measures on Wilmington Avenue, between Sheppard Avenue West and Overbrook Place

BACKGROUND:

The residents in the Bathurst Manor neighbourhood have expressed concern with vehicle volume and speed on the section of roadway along Wilmington Avenue, between Sheppard Avenue West and Overbrook Place and have requested that traffic calming measures be considered.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. The City Clerk be directed to conduct a poll of eligible residents living on Wilmington Avenue and the side streets between Overbrook Place and Sheppard Avenue West in accordance with the City of Toronto Traffic Calming Policy;
2. Transportation Services develop a plan to the City Clerk to be included with the poll;
3. The City Clerk convey the results of the survey to the respondents;
4. Subject to favourable results of the poll:
 - a. Transportation Services undertake the appropriate action to implement the installation of the traffic calming plan on Wilmington Avenue between Sheppard Avenue West and Overbrook Place which is to include a potential cross-walk south of Overbrook Place and north of Sheppard Avenue West
 - b. Lower the speed limit
5. The appropriate city officials be authorized and directed to take whatever action is necessary to implement the forgoing, including the introduction in Council of any Bills that are required.
