The application to amend the Official Plan and former City of North York Zoning By-law No. 7625 proposes to redesignate and rezone the southern third of the property at 1755 Steeles Avenue West to permit the expansion of the existing manufacturing and medical research campus operated by Sanofi Pasteur Limited.

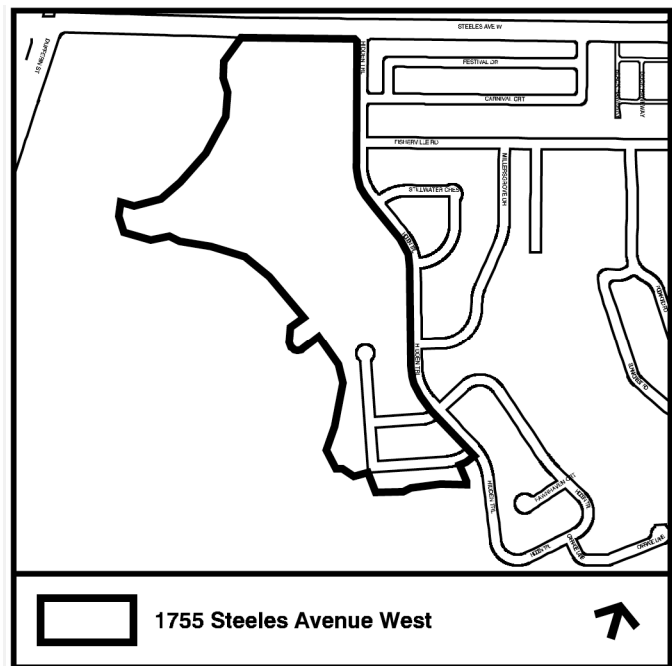
FURTHER INFORMATION

If you wish to be notified of the adoption or refusal of the proposed Official Plan Amendment and/or passing or refusal of the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment you must make a written request to the City Clerk, attention: Merle MacDonald, Committee Administrator, Planning and Growth Management Committee, at the address set out in this notice or by Fax: 416-392-1879.

Official Plan and Zoning By-law Amendments Appeal: If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the City Clerk, attention: Merle MacDonald, Committee Administrator, Planning and Growth Management Committee, at the address set out in this notice or by Fax: 416-392-1879 before the proposed Official Plan Amendment is adopted or refused or the Zoning By-law Amendment is passed or refused, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision to the Ontario Municipal Board and may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

People writing or making presentations at the public meeting: The City of Toronto Act, 2006, the Planning Act, and the City of Toronto Municipal Code authorize the City of Toronto to collect any personal information in your communication or presentation to City Council or its committees.

The City collects this information to enable it to make informed decisions on the relevant issues. If you are submitting letters, faxes, e-mails, presentations or other communications to the City, you should be aware that your name and the fact that you communicated with the City will become part of the public record and will appear on the City's website. The City will also make your communication and any personal information in it - such as your postal address, telephone number or e-mail address - available to the public, unless you expressly request the City to remove it.
